The "Highway Cleanup" is scheduled for March 23, 2024, starting at 7:30 AM. Everyone should meet at The Falls Shopping Plaza on 136th Street and US 1. Three other cleanups are being scheduled for May, September and December of 2024.

Advocate for Social Justice in collaboration with Connection and Social Action, held a "Letter Writing Campaign" on February 10th. There were fifty-four (54) Sorors in attendance. The campaign aimed to advocate for important bills and oppose detrimental ones in the ongoing Florida Legislature sessions, ensuring that they were addressed before the conclusion of committee hearings on February 27th in Tallahassee. It was a concerted effort made to engage beyond the PDO Chapter, reaching out to leadership in Cluster 1 for additional support and advocacy, and also the public, friends, and family.

On February 28th, Sorors participated in Tai Chi exercises from a certified Tai Chi instructor from 5-7 PM. The attendance was very good. They concluded with aerobics, low impact and chair exercises. They were rewarded with health refreshments to end the day.

The committee Co-Chair Jacque Porter related that the center has a Food Bank at the location every 3rd Thursday. They would like to know if Empower Our Families would be interested in partnering with them. The committee accepted.

CHIPP continues to deliver CHIPP Power Packs for students at partner schools Gateway Environmental K- Learning Center and Pine Villa Elementary. They will continue to deliver non-perishable goods to the schools every two weeks. The schools were given "Magic Garden Coloring Books" for the students.
